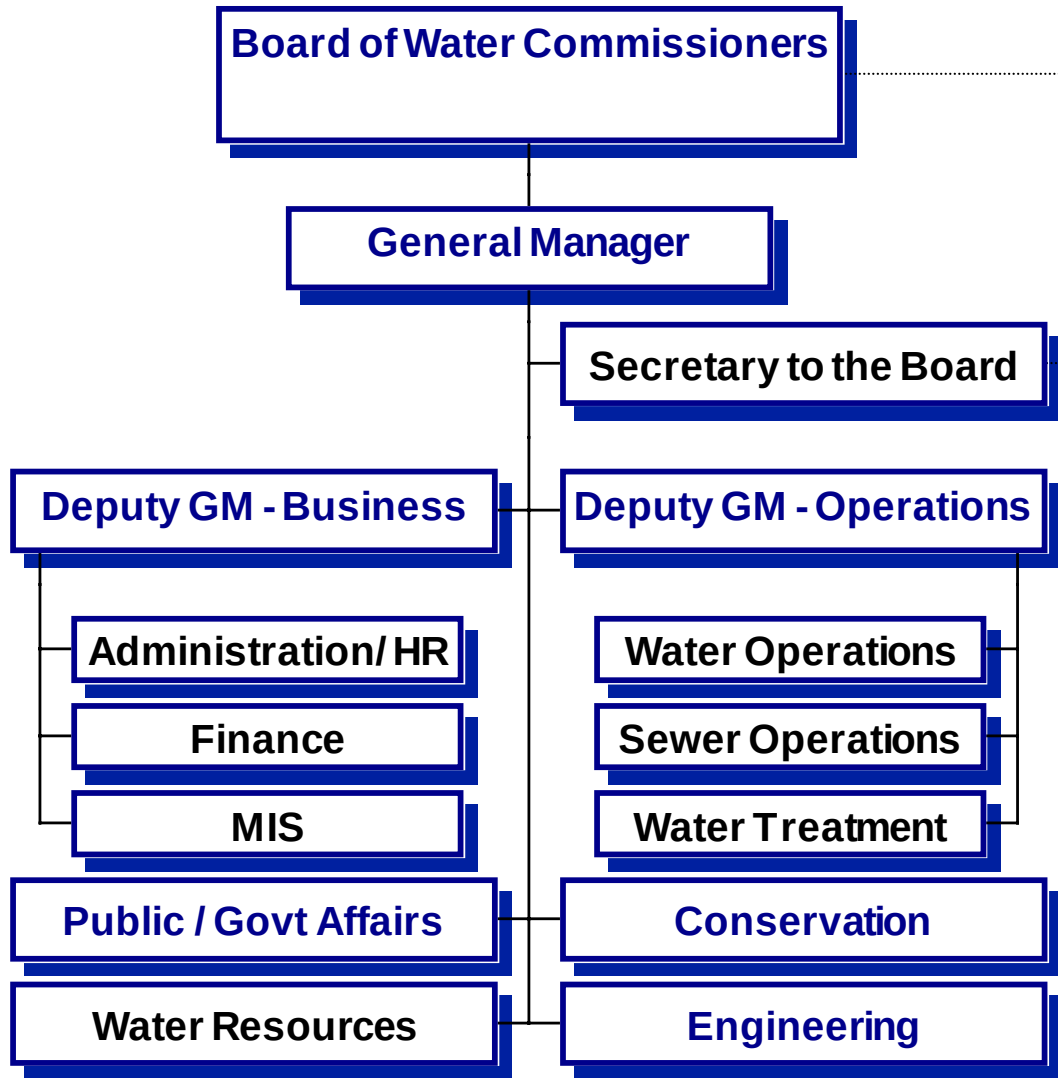


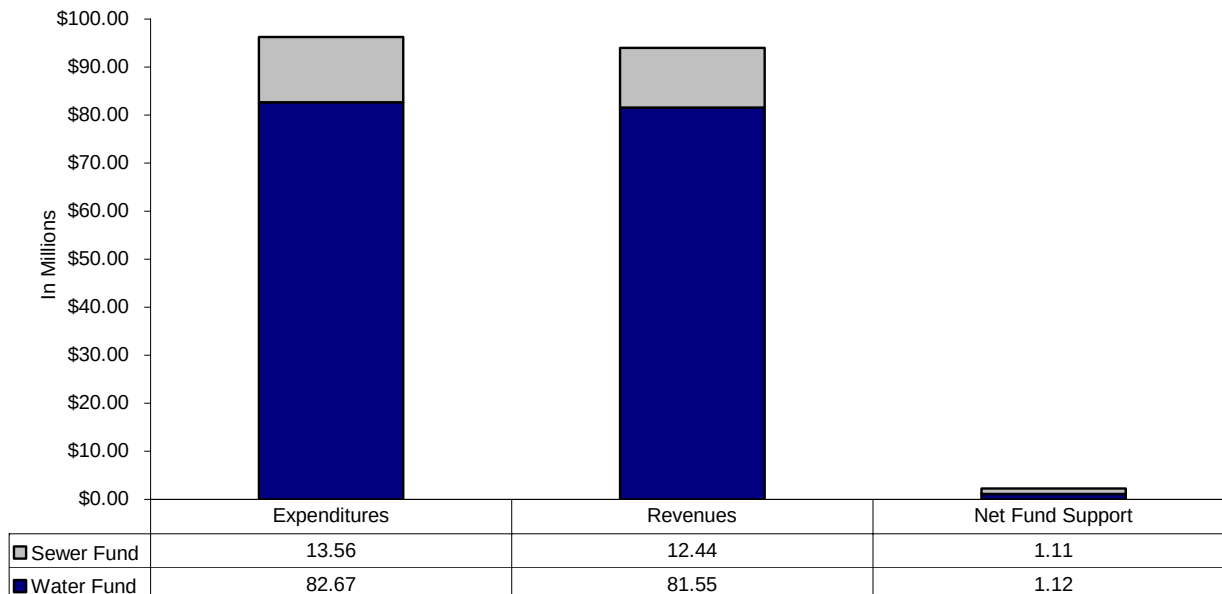


WATER
