

Request for Lead Paint Testing

The Long Beach Community Development Permit Center requires a completed lead paint testing prior to the issuance of any sandblast permit for 1) residential occupancies constructed before 1978 or 2) other structures regardless of age. The Long Beach Department of Health and Human Services (LBDHHS) Laboratory is certified to perform this testing. The test results will be available 7 to 10 business days from the date of your request.
